The Beech King AIR B200 chartered by Norwegian SUNDT AIR is used as the Danish environmental surveillance aircraft within Danish National waters and territories.

- It's equipped with SAAB SLAR, (Side Looking Radar) to detect oil on the surface of the sea
- FLIR Star Fire III.
- Can drop an oil sampling buoy in a pollution.
- Can maintain area awareness from above.

- The Beech King Air B200 is the primary aircraft used for the environmental surveillance task by Sundt air. As a backup for the B200, Sundt Air has a Beech King 350ER if the B200 is unable to fly or otherwise engaged.
