It's summer and vacation time is coming up

Status from the first 6 month of 2022.

SafeSeaNet version 5:

At our newsletter from December 2021 we wrote SafeSeaNet will be updated to version 5 during May 2022 due to new legislation on waste. The develop of version 5 has been delayed and we have assessed that the implementation of the new version shall not take place during the summer vacation period. Therefor we will postponed the new version 5 until after the vacation period. We don't have an exact date yet, but will keep you informed.

2 new ports:

2 new ports have been added to SafeSeaNet.

Tunnelhavn – Rødbyhavn/Tunnel Harbour – Rødbyhavn, locode: DKTHR. This is a new port created for the building of the Fehmarnbelt tunnel.

Tejn Havn – Tejn Port, locoed: DKTEJ: this port is created for the sailing vessels, among others.

Password reset link:

Several of our users have informed us, when they use the password reset link, the email with new link arrives very late or not at all. The message from our IT is: Ask the company's IT to accept all emails from @safeseanet.dk – noreply@safeseanet.dk is the sender for an email with a link to a new password.

Wrong data connected you vessels IMO-number:

When you start up your reporting, and find your vessel has the wrong name at the correct IMO-number, just go ahead and use the correct IMO. When you have created your report, please update your vessels data at "ship identification". After that, write an email to safeseanet@safeseanet.dk and inform us. If you for some reason didn't update the vessels data at "ship identification", please write the ref-number from your report and we will make an update.

Remember to pass on this information to new personal and students; this can save you a lot of time.
