

## **NORDEFECO United Nations Military Police Course**

- Aim** The aim of the course is to impart such knowledge and attitudes to officers and non-commissioned officers from the Nordic and other countries making him/her able to perform MP-Officers functions or to perform MP-Shift Commander's functions in a Multinational MP unit within a UN, NATO or coalition operational area.
- Contents** The course comprises the following subjects and orientations:
- UN organisation, tasks and activities related to peace support operations, including support from military organisations (NATO)
  - The Nordic cooperation related to peace support operations (NORDEFECO),
  - UN and NATO forces authority in different types of missions,
  - Military Police authority in an UN or NATO operational areas,
  - Military Police Operations including:
    - Mobility Support Functions,
    - Law Enforcement Functions,
    - Security Functions
    - Detention Functions
  - Military Police Administration,
  - Radio Communications,
  - Military English,
  - Historical, political, climatic and cultural conditions in potential UN or NATO lead mission areas, including gender issues,
  - Law of Armed Conflict
  - Physical training including Cooper's test.
- Control** There are no examinations at the end of the course, but

each student will be verbally evaluated within the fields of activity during lectures and exercises, proficiency in English, and physical fitness, with focus on the students ability to perform MP functions in a Multinational MP unit operating within a UN, NATO or coalition lead mission.

<b>Certificate</b>	The NORDEFECO UNMILPOC DIPLOMA will be issued.
<b>Duration</b>	17 days (3 weeks including one weekend) including evening lessons approx. every second evening.
<b>Participation</b>	
Category of personnel	Military Police or Civilian Police trained officers and non-commissioned officers before posting to Military Police functions in Peace Support Operations. Legal Advisors which are foreseen to deploy to a peace-keeping mission.
Conditions for Admission	Military Police or Civilian Police training and service as well as a very good knowledge of English.
<b>Number of students</b>	A maximum of 40 students (some 15 officers and some 25 non-commissioned officers). Allocation of seats in accordance with the NORDEFECO Course Manual
<b>Practical information</b>	Students will meet at Military Police, Building 8, Admin Office, Aalborg Barracks, 9400 Noerresundby the first course day before 12 hrs.
<b>Dress code</b>	According to Week Schedule

Students are to bring Best Uniform, Daily Uniform (camouflage or equivalent). Sportswear for indoor/outdoor Physical Training and civilian clothing for off-duty activities, social arrangements and sight-seeing.  
Boots are to be worn during EX Blue Beret.

**Course fee** Besides payment for feeding and accommodation no course fee is presently charged.

**Food and accommodation** Students will be charged € 100 pr. day which will cover accommodation, food, welfare, events etc.

Accommodation in bachelor quarters on base. In the weekend off accommodation will be at a hotel in Aalborg city. No extra charge.

**Miscellaneous** The course is conducted in English. Interpreters are not available.
